

Nurses to Sweden

The nurses are organised in Nursing Colleges which contribute to the development of nursing science and its professional management. In Sweden it is common that experienced nurses are head of departments and participate at the management of the hospital.

Requirements:

Title as BSc. nurse recognised in the EU. If you have received your training in another EEA Member State you need a formal recognition of your professional qualifications before you can start your contract in Sweden.

To be motivated to learn Swedish (C1 level). A free language course will be offered to reach the C1 level.
