

Haematology Nurse to Sweden

Are you interested in working in a well-organised health care system with modern equipment and good working conditions where you can develop professionally? If you are, contact us to start the application process to work in Sweden! Currently, there are open vacancies (full time, permanent positions) for nurses with experience in haematology in the University Hospital in Uppsala.

The Department of Haematology conducts outpatient and inpatient care for patients of all ages with blood and bone marrow diseases.

Examples of haematological diseases treated in the department are acute and chronic leukaemia, myeloma, lymphoma, polycythemia vera and myelodysplastic syndrome. Patients with other diseases, such as MS, are also treated here when stem cell transplantation is included in the treatment.

The clinic consists of a blood reception and a blood department of 22 beds (14 single rooms and 4 doubles. The single rooms are assigned to patients with impaired immune system and who therefore need protection isolation).

There are more than 80 employees, including doctors, nurses, assistant nurses, and physiotherapist. Their catchment area is Uppsala, Dalarna, Gävleborg, Hälsingland, Södermanland, Värmland, Västmanland and Örebro County. In Uppsala, approximately 110 transplants are performed annually. They work actively with colleagues from all over Sweden. They conduct clinical researches and train students and residents.

The hospital offers full-time employment, the possibility of training in working hours and “Good hours” (wish list with day and night service).

We also offer a language and integration program for the whole family.

All our services are free of charge for the candidates.

Requirements:

- Title as BSc. nurse recognised in the EU.
- EU citizenship (or long-term residency permit in the EU).
- Minimum 2-3 years of working experience as haematology nurse.
- To be motivated to learn Swedish (C1 level). A free language course will be offered to reach the C1 level.
- High level of English.
