The post would be 12 months in the first instance with a view to make permanent.

This is a full time post Specialty Doctor in Older Person Medicine. The post will rotate through working in different consultant teams - Duties are based on a 9.00-17.00 with no on calls. There will also be some outpatient duties and some sub specialty training. Candidates are however encouraged to do on calls on an ad hoc basis to meet training needs and service requirements. There will also be a requirement to do occasional weekend work

The successful candidates will work under the supervision of one of the Medicine for the Elderly consultants. They will however be expected to work at a senior (SpR) level. The work programme will be agreed with the applicants to try and meet their educational needs.

The Junior Doctor accepts that he/she will also perform duties in occasional emergencies and unforeseen circumstances at the request of the appropriate Consultant and in consultation where practicable with his/her colleagues both junior and senior.
